ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a registered voter of Torreon/Star Lake Chapter for at least 6 months for students over 18 years old; or parent must be a registered voter for 1 year prior to applying for students under 18 years of age.
- 2. Must be enrolled full-time or parttime in an accredited college, university, vocational institution, or technical school.
- 3. Must be a member of the Navajo Nation with a census number.

- 1. Current Scholarship Application
- 2. Letter of Acceptance
- 3. Copy of Social Security Card
- 4. Copy of CIB (Certificate of Indian Blood)
- 5. Copy of photo ID
- 6. Original High School or College Transcript
- 7. Current Class Schedule
- Voter Registration/Voter Registration for Parent/Guardian (if under 18 years old)

CONTINUING APPLICANT:

- 1. Current Scholarship Application
- 2. Final Grades (Official Transcript or Parchment Delivery ID)
- 3. Copy of Receipts from prior semester (showing payment)
- 4. GPA (must be at least 2.0)
- 5. Current Class Schedule
- 6. Completion of 8 hours of community service (Letter)
- 7. Attendance and Academic Progress from prior semester.
- 8. Voter Registration

ALL Documents must be turned in BEFORE the deadline. An application with missing documents will not be considered. NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE.
