

"Christmas in Na'Neelzhiin" Parade Rules

The parade is meant to be fun for the community; however, safety is the number one priority for both parade entrants and spectators.

- 1. **SAFETY:** Public safety is of the utmost importance. Participants must always follow the directions of Parade Staff.
- 2. **GAPS AND PACE**: While in parade route, entries should be 15' 20' apart to keep pace and drive in a straight line. Do not cause gaps. Speed limit 7-10mph.
- 3. **ENTRIES:** Appropriate entries will be accepted in the parade by a confirmation email. All entries must drive in a straight line. Only approved vehicles will be allowed into the parade.
- 4. **ANIMALS:** Well-behaved animals are welcome. All groups with animals are required to pick up their animal's waste.
- 5. <u>LIGHTS:</u> All entries, including two-vehicles, walkers and riders, must be decorated with holiday lighting. All entries are required to have as many lights as possible. Digital screens do **not** count as lights.
- 6. **SOUND:** Holiday music is encouraged at a reasonable volume. The use of sirens and vehicle horns are **not** permitted during the event. Sound systems may not be used for broadcasting messages or agendas.
- 7. **RELIGION:** Religious expression is permitted, but please be respectful to all faiths.
- 8. **SIZE:** Entry height is open no restrictions.
- 9. MATERIALS: All materials used must be flame retardant. A properly rated, currently tagged fire extinguisher is required for each applicable entry. All wiring must be secured to prevent personal injury and equipment damage. All connections must be made with UL-approved electrical boxes and devices. Portable generators/compressors must be securely mounted, and a minimum distance of one foot from any combustible material. Generators/Compressors must be equipped with firmly attached exhaust systems that terminate into common exhaust serving the vehicle or in the same manner of vehicle exhaust. Insurance and liability are the sole responsibility of the entrant. The Sandoval County Fire Department will have final say on all regulations.
- 10. **HANDOUTS:** Throwing of any items is strictly prohibited. PLEASE DO NOT THROW CANDY. Walking entrants may hand out appropriate holiday items.
- 11. **STAGING:** All entries must enter staging through the correct turn off which is Trujillo's Turn Off at 5:30pm and end at the Torreon Chapter House.
- 12. **RULES:** All Entries must follow the rules, the parade information packet, and Parade staff directions.
