POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

These policies and procedures will supersede the TCDC Resolution for the Chapter Scholarship Assistance.

All potential applicants that are requesting scholarship assistance for educational purposes shall oblige by these policies and procedures. (Resolution #TSL 059-10/2015)

Before a potential applicant can be eligible for scholarship assistance, he or she must be on the Regular Meeting Agenda with completed and accurate documents. The deadline date will vary and will also be based on Fund Availability for Scholarship.

FALL SEMESTER

Opening: July 1st

Deadline: July 31st

SPRING SEMESTER

Opening: December 1st

Deadline: December 31st

Attend January Chapter Meeting

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a registered voter of the Torreon/Star Lake Chapter for at least 6 months for students over 18 years old or parent must be a registered voter for 1 year prior to applying for students under 18 years of age
- Must be enrolled full-time or part-time in an accredited college, university, vocational institution, or technical school
- Must be a member of the Navajo Nation with a census number

PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP

Assist with educational expenses such as tuition, books, school supplies, or room and board

STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

Upon award, the student must meet the following conditions:

- Utilize the awarded funds toward educational needs and goals
- Submit requested transcript at the end of each awarded semester

ROLE OF STUDENT

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- Student shall come to the Chapter to obtain and submit all essential documents to the Chapter Office in a timely manner
- Student/Parent shall conduct themselves in a professional manner
- Student shall be present at the Planning and Regular meetings

5. Current Class Schedule
6. 8 hrs. Community Service
7. Attendance and Academic Progress from prior semester
8. Voter Registration

ALL documents must be turned in before the deadline. An application with missing documents will no be considered. **NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON OR AFTER THE DEADLINE.**
